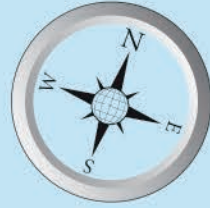
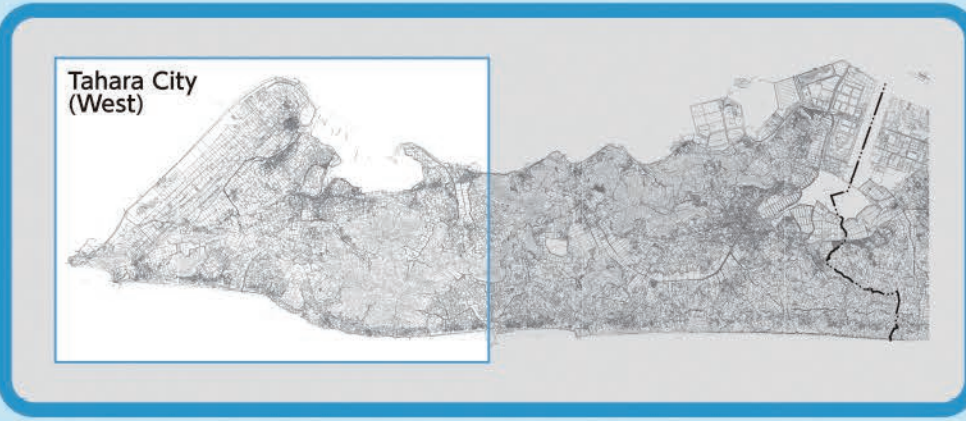

***Tsunami Damage Danger Zone**
These areas were designated by the Governor of Aichi Prefecture on July 30, 2019, based on the Act on Tsunami Disaster Prevention Area Development. These are areas where there is a risk of danger to the lives or bodies of residents in the event of the largest class of Tsunami. They are designated for the purpose of preventing human damage caused by Tsunami.

***Reference Water Level (m)**
The reference water level is based on the backwater height of tsunami caused by a collision with a building, etc., and is displayed as the height from the ground elevation.

***Tsunami Evacuation Zone**
Areas designated by the city, school zones, and community associations as areas with potential for damage from flooding in consideration of the estimated tsunami inundation area and past tsunami disaster history (estimated tsunami inundation areas of Tahara City "Survey on Tsunami Damage by M9.0 of Tokai/Tsushima/Nankai Earthquake")

***Landslide Danger Stream**
Mountain stream that has the potential to cause landslides with damage to more than 1 house

***Steep Slope Locations with Potential Danger**
Steep slopes with greater than 30-degree inclination and greater than 5 meter height with more than 1 house in the potential damage zone

***Landslide Damage Danger Zone**
Area with steep slope that when destroyed by disaster may endanger the health and lives of the residents.

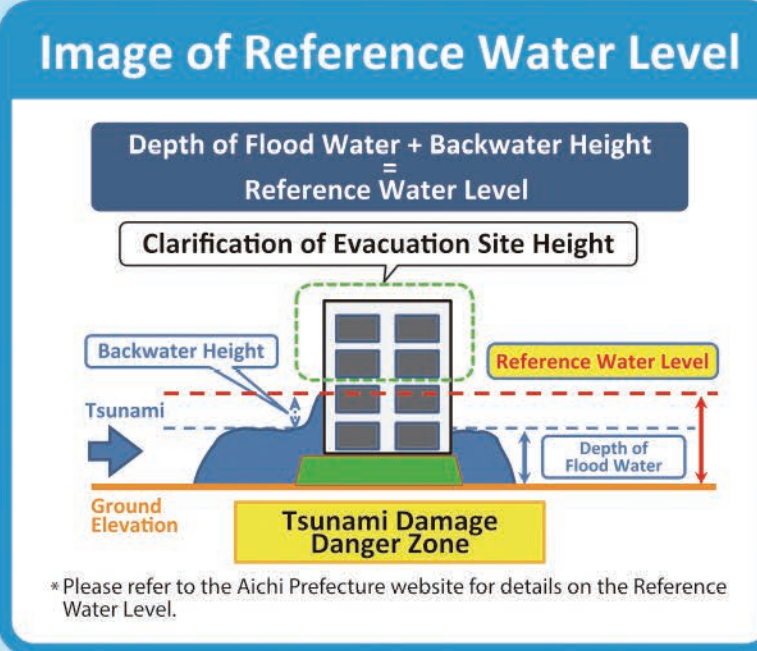
***Landslide Damage Special Danger Zone**
Areas in the Landslide Damage Danger Zone in which damaged structures may significantly endanger the health and lives of the residents.
